

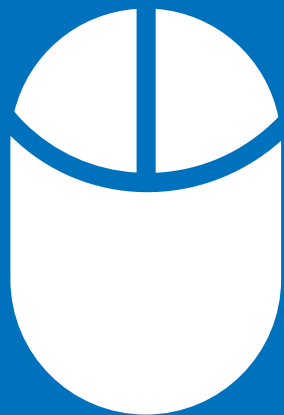

Our free services provide help across five vital areas:

- ✓ helping you decide whether Direct Payments are the right option for you
- ✓ helping you organise and purchase the support you need if you decide to choose the Direct Payments route
- ✓ helping you with the ongoing management of your Direct Payments
- ✓ providing peer support so that you can talk to other people with experience of Direct Payments
- ✓ help you develop a support plan to show you how you use or will use your Direct Payment or Personal Budget

Our services are available to people who are interested in, or already receiving, Direct Payments.
